Trail Passes:	Trail day passes for all three days are included in the registration fee for competitors. Other users, including coaches and event support personnnel, must purchase a day pass from the Information Centre.

Waxing/Warming Facilities:	The lodge will be available to athletes for changing and warming. A warming tent will also be available near the start/finish line. Fluoro Waxes:	High fluoro (HF) glide wax and high fluoro (HF) add-on powders, pucks and liquids are <i>not permitted</i> in categories Midget boys/Midget girls and younger.
Food Services:	A food concession will be available at the race venue. Drinking water will be available.
Parking:	<i>Parking space is limited.</i> On-site parking will be reserved for disabled participants and volunteers. Families, teams and support personnel are asked to park at Uncas School where shuttle buses will be used to access the race venue (map: <u>here</u> ). Vehicles will be allowed to drop-off athletes and gear. <i>Please, do not transport skiing equipment on the shuttle buses.</i>

# **RACE LICENSE AND REQUIREMENTS**

Race License requirements will be as per Cross Country Alberta and Cross Country Canada directives. All competitors Juvenile category and older must have a valid CCC or FIS license to be entered during on-line registration. A CCC supporting member license (day license) may be purchased during the on-line registration for a fee of \$5.00/day for competitors in Juvenile and up who do not have a racing license. *Competitors aged Midget and younger must be a member of a CCC registered club, but do not require a license.* 

# **INFORMED CONSENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT/WAIVER**

During the on-line registration process on Zone 4 each participant must sign Cross Country Canada's Informed Consent and Assumption of Risk Agreement.
